Royal Mencap are officially launching a new 'online community' for families and people with a learning disability. Mencap's online community is a safe and supportive place to ask questions. The community is part of HealthUnlocked and is moderated by both Mencap's community staff (administrators) and health Unlocked.

Royal Mencap values and supports people with a learning disability. The new online community is a safe place for anyone with an interest in learning disabilities to share stories and experiences with their peers, ask questions and offer support. You might be a parent, a family member, a sibling, a friend or a person with a learning disability who would like to have a conversation online with other likeminded people.

Mencap are also planning expert online events where you can post questions for an expert to answer. The first of these is planned for early July, so keep an eye out.

When you write a post, you will be given the option for 'Anyone' to see the post or 'Only community members'. If you choose 'Only community members' then it will not be visible to anyone outside that community. Google will still pick it up but only part of the post will be visible. Bear in mind that many people who visit the online community are not members and will only read posts. They may benefit greatly from reading your posts so think carefully about restricting access to your post.


