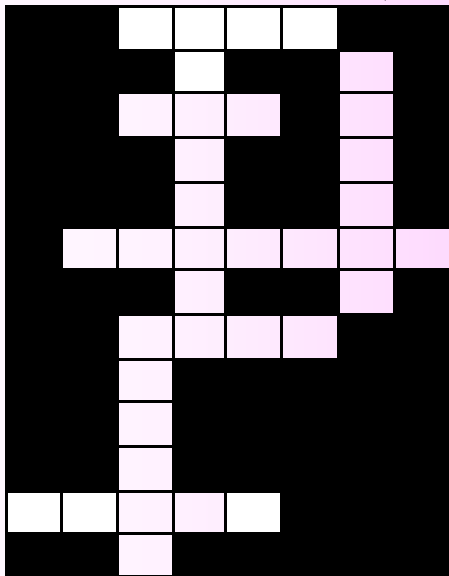

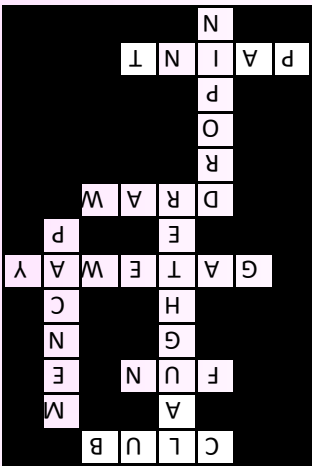









Another little something to craft if you have time on
your hands whilst at home.

<p>Description of activity</p>	<p>Craft – wool art, using thick PVA glue and wool to glue into various shapes and left to dry as a hanging or wall decoration.</p>
<p>Materials needed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thick wool (A ball of multi-coloured wool is best here) • Greaseproof paper (Must have) • PVA glue (Do not dilute) • scissors 
<p>Instructions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut a piece of greaseproof paper (about the size of a chopping board (A3 sized)) • Dip the length of thick wool into the thick undiluted PVA glue and lay / arrange on the sheet of greaseproof paper. Swirl the wool into a pleasing shape and leave to dry. (This will be the look of your finished article.) • When <u>DRY</u>, peel carefully off the greaseproof paper and admire. • The work of art if solid enough, can be strung up or hung on the wall.
